Our waste treatment/stabilization (to pass EPA paint filter test) capabilities offer an expedited option to delays caused by similar services at landfills. We are open 24 hours a day, seven days a week, unlike some stabilization cells at landfill facilities. We adhere to all OSHA regulations including 29CFR 1910.1096 (radiation protection standard), we monitor our workers for direct ionizing radiation as well as Radon-222 daughter products. We limit your risk by removing a potentially hazardous operation from the well pad site, to our environmentally friendly pre-engineered facility.

Ground Tech also offers state of the art tank cleaning which can be done remotely, no entry, no confined space, and no worker exposure. AMS radiation protection professionals monitor our tank cleaning crews to ensure compliance with all state and federal regulations. Tanker trucks can be cleaned without damage to their internal liners. Eliminates cross contamination between loads and if requested can be certified clean. Frac tanks/vacuum boxes can be vacuumed out and water blasted clean to hold your fresh water. No cross contamination between sites or other customers and if requested can be certified free of radiological contamination.
